Special Al-Andalus Halal

1st day: Arrival at MALAGA airport

Arrival and transfer to the Halal hotel on the Costa del Sol on a half board basis.

2nd day: GRANADA

Buffet breakfast and departure to Granada (129 km) Meeting with a local guide and visit of: Alhambra Palaces + Carlos V Palace + Generalife Gardens + panoramic tour. Free time for lunch and return to the Hotel. Dinner and accommodation.

3rd day: SEVILLA

Breakfast and departure to SEVILLA (215 km) Meeting with a local guide for a walking tour and visit of: The Cathedral, the Real Alcázar, the Barrio de Santa Cruz, and a panoramic bus tour to visit the Plaza de España, the Park de María Luisa and the premises of the EXPO 1929 and 1992. Free time for lunch and return to the hotel, dinner and accommodation.

4th day: CORDOBA

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to CORDOBA (187kms) Meeting with the local guide and visit of: the Mosque-Cathedral, the old town, the Patios, the Roman Bridge and the Calahorra Tower. Free time for lunch and return to the hotel. Dinner and accommodation.

5th and 6th days: MÁLAGA - COSTA DEL SOL

Free day at your Hotel on the Costa del Sol to go shopping (with personal shopper and great discounts), beach or discover the city of Malaga - the cathedral, the Picasso Museum, etc. Half board accommodation.

7th day: MÁLAGA / AIRPORT

Breakfast and free time until transfer to the airport for your departure flight.





Costa del Sol and Morocco

Day 1: MÁLAGA

Arrival and transfer to your hotel on the Costa del Sol.

Day 2 COSTA DEL SOL

Free day with half board on the coast.

Day 3 COSTA DEL SOL-FES (Sunday)

Breakfast. Departure to Algeciras or Tarifa to board the ferry that crosses the Strait of Gibraltar to Africa. Arrival in Morocco and after customs continuation by bus to the old town of Fez. Dinner and accommodation.

Day 4 FES

Media blackboard. Visit of the city of Fez in the morning, visiting the Medersa, the first university in the Islamic world, the old Kasbah and its narrow streets, the tanners' quarter, the Najerine fountain, the great Medina, considered a World Heritage Site ... Free afternoon.

Day 5 FES-MEKNES-MARRAKECH

Breakfast. Departure for Meknes. Panoramic tour of this ancient walled imperial city, with the beautiful gate "Bab El Mansour", and continuation through the Middle Atlas mountains to Marrakech. Dinner and accommodation.

Day 6 MARRAKECH

Media blackboard. Sightseeing tour of the city in the morning visiting the Royal Palace of the Summer Bay, the Saadi Tombs, the Koutoubia Tower and the famous Djemaa el Fnaa square with great and exotic activity. Free afternoon to discover this exciting city on your own.

Day 7 MARRAKECH-CASABLANCA-RABAT

Breakfast and departure to Casablanca. Panoramic tour of this cosmopolitan city. In the afternoon continuation to Rabat, capital of the Kingdom of Morocco. Dinner and night.

Day 8 RABAT - TANGIER

Breakfast. Panoramic tour visiting the exterior of the Royal Palace, official residence of the King, Mausoleum of Mohamed V and Hassan Tower. We continue our trip to Tangier, with a panoramic drive before arriving at the hotel for dinner and accommodation.

Day 9 TANGIER-COSTA DEL SOL

Breakfast. Departure to board the ferry and cross the Strait back to Spain. Arrival to the Costa del Sol. Dinner and night

Day 10 MÁLAGA

Breakfast and transfer to the airport to take your flight.

Imperial cities

Day 1 SATURDAY: CASABLANCA

Welcome at Mohammed V airport by our staff. Delivery of your vouchers and your travel documents. Brief overview of the tour during your transfer to the hotel. Check in, dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 2 SUNDAY: CASABLANCA / RABAT (95 km)

Breakfast, visit of the economic capital of Morocco: the central market, the Habous district, the Royal Palace, the Mohamed V square, the residential area of Anfa and the exterior of the Hassan II mosque. Fish lunch in one of the restaurants facing the sea as an option. Continuation to Rabat, visit of the city: the Royal Palace, (Mechouar), the Kasbah of Oudaya, the Mohamed V mausoleum, the Hassan Tower. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 3 MONDAY: RABAT / MEKNES / FEZ (220 km)

Breakfast, departure to Meknes and visit of the capital of Ismalia famous for its 40 km long walls, visit of Bab Mansour, the royal stables and the Jewish quarter. After lunch option, continuation to the holy city of Moulay Idriss, and through the ruins of the Roman city of Volubilis, continuation to Fez. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

DAY 04 TUESDAY: FEZ

Breakfast, All day is dedicated to the sightseeing of the city of Fez, the religious capital of Morocco: the medieval medina with its Attarine and Bou Anania Medersas, the Nejjarine fountain, the Moulay Idriss mausoleum and the Karaouine mosque Moroccan lunch in a Traditional Restaurant in the Medina as an option. Afternoon visit of Fez Jdid. Optional dinner show in local restaurant. and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 5 WEDNESDAY: FEZ / BENI MELLAL / MARRAKECH (485 km)

Breakfast, departure to Marrakech passing through the Berber village of Immouzer du Kandar and Ifrane. Optional lunch and a moment of relaxation in Beni Mellal, optionally one of the agricultural centers of Morocco. Arrival in Marrakech in the late afternoon. Check in at the hotel, dinner and accommodation.

Day 6 THURSDAY: MARRAKECH

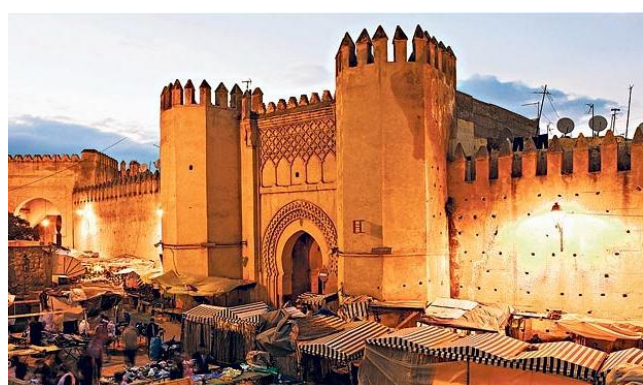
Breakfast, Visit of the historical Marrakech: the Menara garden, the Saadian tombs, the Bahia Palace, the Koutoubia and the Dar Si Saïd Museum. Lunch at the local restaurant optional. In the afternoon, visit the famous Djemaa El Fnaa square with its surrounding souks and handicraft quarters. Dinner with optional fantasy show. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 7 FRIDAY: MARRAKECH / CASABLANCA (250 km)

Stay in a Cave House in Guadix and take in your suitcase the unforgettable memory of a balloon ride through one of the most important geoparks in Spain.

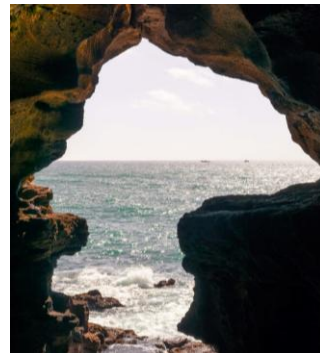


Tangier in one day

EXCURSIONES

Then we return to the Costa del Sol.



GIBRALTAR

We leave the Costa del Sol at the indicated directions and exit to Gibraltar. We leave our hotel and drive along the coast until we reach Gibraltar, border crossing and tour of the city by minibus.

The tour includes the entrance to the cave of San Miguel and the monkey reserve.

Free time and return to the Costa del Sol. Don't forget your ID card or passport



SEVILLE

We leave Costa del Sol at the indicated directions and departure to Seville. Seville has a special color! Seville has a special color, as they say in a Spanish song and that is true.

We will feel it when we walk through one of the largest Old Quarters in Europe, where we will visit the Cathedral and the Alcázar, the Santa Cruz neighborhood, and the Plaza de España, La Plaza de España. Free time for lunch and then return to the Costa del Sol in the afternoon..



NERJA AND FRIGILIANA

Departure from various pick-up points and Hotels on the Costa del Sol to Frigiliana and free time to visit this white town with narrow streets and the center of the Moorish city. We continue to the Caves of Nerja and visit these famous caves formed about 75 million years ago and discovered in 1959. Their enormous spaces of stalactites and stalagmites are reflected in their interior rivers and lakes. Once the visit is finished, we continue to Nerja and free time until the previously established time to return to the Costa del Sol.



MOROCCO

We leave the Costa del Sol at the indicated directions and exit to Tarifa along the entire coast. Upon our arrival in Algeciras or Tarifa, we embark for Tangier.

Our local guide awaits us upon arrival and we visit the city, a mixture of European culture and Islamic traditions, which still preserves a cosmopolitan atmosphere from its colonial past.

Enter its Medina, walk through its Zouks and enjoy all the different fragrances and colors of its perfumes, spices, fabrics, until you reach the Kasbah. Lunch will be offered in a typical restaurant. At the scheduled time, we will go to the port and embark back to Spain towards one of the ports mentioned above where the bus will be waiting for us to take us back to the Costa del Sol.



CORDOBA

We leave Costa del Sol at the indicated and exit towards Córdoba. Upon arrival we will begin our visit to the Mosque-Cathedral, La Mezquita, an authentic creation made of columns and arches, a symbol of the city and declared a World Heritage Site. Later a short walk through the Jewish area and free time to have lunch or continue discovering the city on our own.



RONDA AND MARBELLA

We leave the Costa del Sol by the indicated indications and exit towards Ronda, known for famous bandits and with a strong bullfighting tradition.

Its impressive Tagus with magnificent views can be enjoyed from the New and Arab Bridges. The depth of the Tagus reaches 120 meters.

We will start the tour with the bullring, built in the 18th century. It is the oldest in the world. We will also visit the Wine Museum and taste its exquisite wine.

Back on the coast, we make a stop in Marbella with a visit to the old town. We will admire the Plaza Los Naranjos, the Town Hall, the local church, the Chapel of San Juan de Dios and the park.



FLAVOR OF RURAL ANDALUCIA + OIL MILL WITH SPECIAL HOMEMADE FOOD FROM THE MEDITERRANEAN

At the scheduled time, pick up at the hotel and departure to the town of Alfaratejo, a region that offers the opportunity to admire the best and unforgettable views of the wonderful landscapes and mountains, called "The South Pyrenees" of the province of Malaga.

During the tour, we will pass through the oldest olive groves in Spain, and we will have the opportunity to stop to see up close and take beautiful pictures.

We will continue with a visit to the Oil Factory, where you can learn about the process of making the famous and world-renowned "Extra Virgin Olive Oil", which you can taste together with the typical Spanish homemade bread of the region, also known as "Pan Cathetus".

Guided walk through the center of the town of Alfaratejo, with its narrow streets, the Church, and we will end with a stop for a "Sweet Wine" tasting.

Once we return to the square, we will be welcomed by "Las Mamas", who will offer us a lunch at their homes, enjoying their company and tasting the typical Spanish cuisine of the region. After lunch we will return to the Costa del Sol.



DISCOVER CAMINITO DEL REY

Today is a very impressive day, we will have a trekking experience with the visit of Caminito Del Rey in Ardales. It is a pedestrian walkway built into the walls of the Los Gaitanes gorge. It is 2.9 kilometers long, attached to the rock inside a canyon, with sections of a width of only 1 meter, hanging up to 100 meters above the river, on almost vertical walls. In total, our walking tour will last about 2h30min, since there are 4.7 km of access roads. This narrow path, built at the beginning of the 20th century, that runs along the right side of the gorge, was used for the transport service between a small dam at the beginning of the water channel in Gaitanejo and the El Chorro hydroelectric ravine located beyond the cliff of the Gran Gaitán King Alfonso XIII crossed the footbridge in 1921 for the inauguration of the Conde del Guadalhorce dam and it became known as Camino del Rey (English: King's pathway). Along the years, the trail was badly damaged. It was very dangerous to use it, and the connection between different towns disappeared and was finally closed in 2000. After four years of extensive repairs and renovations, the walkway reopened on March 29, 2015 and along the way you can see the old way.



Gastronomic Malaga

We discover with you an exciting historical and culinary journey through one of the most beautiful cities in Andalusia.

First, we will visit one of the most typical restaurants in Malaga to taste Churros and Chocolate. After the first culinary stop we continue exploring Malaga. We will show you the famous monuments of Malaga with a stop at the Cathedral "La Manquita" and the Alcazaba. We will continue with a walk through the Soho neighborhood and Pier 1.

At the end of the tour we will enjoy a traditional sweet wine, in a typical Andalusian winery. Lunch in a restaurant in Malaga and free time to shop or visit the city center a little more.





Antequera: emotions, adventure and culture

Option 1: Caminito & Dolmenes

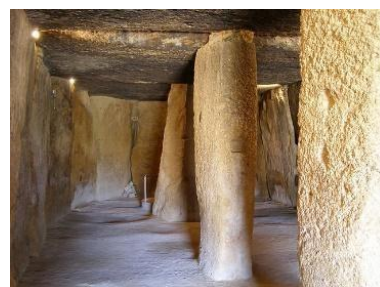
We begin our visit with a hiking route in Ardales, Caminito del Rey. This beautiful area, which treasures historical treasures and beautiful landscapes, is located in the center of the province of Malaga, and is surrounded by the Serranía de Ronda and Antequera. In this union of towns and natural landscapes, El Caminito del Rey has always been an essential link. It was built for practical reasons with concrete walkways hanging over the cliffs of the Gualdalhorce River in the spectacular gorge Desfiladero de los Gaitanes to connect both parts of the novel hydroelectric ravine of the 20th century.



A stop for lunch at a restaurant in Ardales - El Chorro and we continue to Dólmenes. Return to the Hotel in the afternoon.

Option 2: Antequera and Dolmens

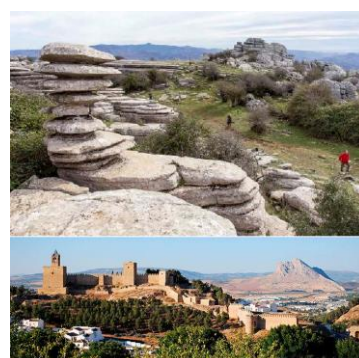
We start or visit with a city tour in Antequera. This town is a very dynamic city due to its historical role and, today, it is in a central position for communication in Andalusia. However, for this reason, some buildings and infrastructures have recently been built in the visual protection zone, however, they are not tall buildings and do not hinder the view of these natural elements. Lunch in a typical restaurant of the city. We continue with the visit of the Antequera Dolmen.



The dolmens are outstanding examples of megalithic architecture and are among the most recognized and valued in the world and have recently been declared a World Heritage Site. In addition, they are connected to two first-rate landmarks: the Rock of the Enamorados and the mountains of El Torcal, Antequera.

Option 3: Torcal and Dolmenes

We start the visit with a hiking route in Torcal. The Torcal del Paraje Natural de Antequera is home to one of the most impressive karst (limestone) landscapes in Europe. There are two trails for hiking and they are ideal for exploring this city. The path from the Torcal Alto Visitor Center, known as the green route, will show you the most spectacular karst formations. You can walk through the "Dark Alley" and the "Tobacco Alley". A stop for lunch at a restaurant in Antequera and we continue with the visit of Dolmenes.



Option 4: Antequera and Torcal

We begin or visit with a city tour in the upper part of Antequera, stopping at La Alcazaba, Arco de los Gigantes and collegiate church of Santa Maria la Mayor. Lunch in a typical restaurant in Antequera. We continue with a hiking route in Torcal.
